The Adler Center for Caring on the Van Metre Campus

The Capital Caring Health Adler Center for Caring on the Van Metre Campus is among the most state-of-the-art inpatient hospice facilities in the nation. With 21 beds, the Adler Center is situated just off Route 50 in Loudoun County. Individual patient rooms, as well as a country kitchen, patient spa, and grand living room make this warm and inviting facility an oasis of quality care.

Located on the same campus is the Capital Caring Health Center for Pain and Palliative Care (CPPC). The CPPC provides interventional pain management services for patients requiring acute palliative care. Patients with advanced disease symptoms that impair their capacity to enjoy life fully benefit from the various interventional therapies, enabling them to return to their daily routines.

Memorial and Naming Opportunities for The Great Room, a welcoming place for families, our Garden Meditation Labyrinth, Patient Rooms (nine remaining), and other indoor and outdoor areas are available from \$1,000 to \$500,000.

Capital Caring Health Halquist Memorial Inpatient Center

The 15-bed Halquist Memorial Inpatient Center located in the former Woodlawn Elementary School is a peaceful, serene facility tucked into the warmly shaded street in residential Arlington. Acute hospice care is provided by a skilled team of clinicians where families can enjoy the tranquility of the Center's gardens, maintained for nearly 30 years by a group of dedicated volunteers.

While renovations have occurred over the years, this 1940s flagship center is due for major renovations. Please inquire should you be interested in helping us achieve such an important effort.

The Gardens are a joy to patients, families, and visitors. Donations of \$2,500 and up are received for outdoor beautification. Additionally, please contact us to learn more about our Building Fund and help us renovate our first 'hospice house'.

Capital Caring Health Greenbelt Center is the first and only facility of this nature located in Prince George's County, Maryland. This short-term acute care setting offers seven private bedrooms located on the third-floor wing at Arbor Terrace Senior Living in Lanham, Maryland. The center is focused on short term intense comfort care to relieve discomforting symptoms such as pain, breathing difficulties, and nausea that need to be managed in a controlled setting. The center's boutique style is a warm and welcoming home away from home.

Seven private rooms are available for naming at a gift of \$10,000 per room.

Our inpatient location in Northeast Washington, DC is the first such unit in the nation's capital. The 14-bed inpatient hospice unit includes private rooms, family kitchen, nursing station, and waiting area, all within a comfortable, home-like setting, in addition to providing care for some of the region's most underserved families.

Our new headquarters provides an exceptional environment for staff to work and to learn. Most importantly, it houses services for our patients and their families.
